Is...

Digital Notetaking app for free-form information gathering and multi-user collaboration

*MIEE declaration

Does...

It gathers users' notes (handwritten or typed), drawings, screen clippings and audio commentaries

So What?

- Its free for students as part of their Office365
- It enables grouping by sections with unlimited pages for documents, photos, emails, spreadsheets, recordings, and inking
- Share via email or work together in real time
- Clip the web and retain the reference
- Integrates with the Office Suite

For Students?

Most students Undergraduate & Postgraduate do the following

- Do a lot of notetaking (for a variety of reasons, to a range of quality and within a number of methodologies)
- Attend multiple lectures, seminars, workshops, supervision sessions.
- Collaborate with others students and peers on group projects or collaborative creations.
- Record Audio and Video for later consumption or review.
- In short the requirement to manage and curate a flood of info into a neat and tidy searchable personalised space ideally accessible immediately from any platform.
